#### General Vendor Rules:

All vendors should be on the grounds and totally set-up by 8:30 a.m.

Event is being held rain or shine. Please stay on roads as directed if all/some grassy areas are too wet for vehicle traffic.

Event helpers will be allowed to set-up between 6 and 8 p.m. on Friday evening (May 5). Special "early bird" exceptions will also be made for those with complex displays, those camping on-site or those staying in a local hotel/motel. Please call Steve or Rick in advance at the numbers listed on the front of this flyer to discuss any potential set-up challenges.

If possible, you'll be directed to your space(s) at the first gate based on the majority of the items you're trying to sell (i.e. gas engine & tractor parts, garden tractors/parts, car parts, general antiques, tools, crafts, household, etc.). Please drive slowly and set-up reasonably close to other vendors so the entire swap area is not excessively spread out. There will be limited access to some covered pavilions on the grounds on a first to arrive basis.

Space fees will be collected (cash only) from all vendors starting at 10 a.m. Armbands will be used to prove vendor payments. They must be displayed at the vendor's site immediately upon payment (i.e. wrapped around table leg, tailgate support, trailer frame) so payment collectors know who paid if a second pass to collect is needed.

Be respectful to event organizers, fellow vendors and the general public.
